



CLOS TROTEGOTTE, EMMANUEL RYBINSKI VIN DE FRANCE "K-LIBRE" CHARDONNAY 2016



The family vineyard, entirely replanted in 1987 by Emmanuel's father, is a single block of 29 acres located on the unique plateau of iron-rich limestone of Villesèque, small village situated at an elevation of 1,400 feet.

Certified organic since 2014 and **Certified Biodynamic** since 2017.

The name "K-libre" has multiple meanings. First, it follows the visual of the entire line of wines of the estate that are all given names starting or finishing with a "K", the first syllabus of Cahors. Second "Klibre", or "calibre", is the slang for gun, in that case Manu's secret weapon as a wine. And finally "libre" which means "free", since this wine and all the other under this name are aged in Amphora with no addition of SO2.

SOIL TYPE _____

On the plateau of Cahors made of Clay and "Siderolithique" limestone . Iron rich type of soil that gives finesse and texture.

VARIETAL _____

100% Chardonnay – Yield: 40 hl/H or 2 tons/acre

CULTURE _____

Organic treatment such as Trace element, marine algae (Photosynthesis), Orange terpene (Mildiou/Oidium) & sulfur.
Disbudding in June, Grape removing in July. Natural grass cover between the row. Manual harvesting with parcel selection.

VINIFICATION _____

Carbonic maceration. Fermentation at cold temperature with native yeasts and without SO2.
Ageing on fine lees in red clay amphora during 6 months with no addition of SO2. Only 10mg of SO2 per litter added at the bottling. 250 cases produced.

TASTING NOTES _____

This natural wine aged in the most neutral content has everything to express the purest expression of Chardonnay. The fruit is ripe and dense yet displaying a bright mineral acidity. Aromas of peach and nectarines nicely balanced by a touch of citrus. Clean and lively finish.
